The National University of Educational Planning and Administration (NUEPA), established by the Ministry of Human Resource Development, Government of India, is a premier organization dealing with research and capacity building in planning and administration of education, not only in India but also in South Asia. In recognition of the pioneering work done by the organization in the field of educational planning and administration, the Government of India has upgraded it to the status of a National University. Like any Central University, NUEPA is fully maintained by the Government of India. 5. Candidates from outside Delhi called for interview shall be paid TA as per entitlement for the posts of Professor and 2 AC train fare for other posts by shortest route.
6. Minimum requirements of qualifications and/of experience may be relaxed in respect of exceptionally outstanding candidate. The University reserves the right to increase or decrease the number of positions, to fill up or not to fill up any or all the posts or to shortlist and select the candidates in any suitable position depending upon the qualification and experience required for the said posts.
